Bright white woodwork and bedding would have felt stark. Instead, Hammel chose a more mellow oatmeal tone. "It's warmer and feels more cozy," she says.

To supply a new build with instant coziness, designer Mark Cunningham transformed a white box into a cocoon of earth tones. Inspired by the sofa's sage linen, he painted walls and trim tone-ontone green (similar to Benjamin Moore Avon Green). Varying the finishes—flat on the valls, satin on the trim—adds depth, while furnishings in a range of sandy hues give the room warmth and texture.
